Bill Lane Scholarship Award Requirements

Scholarships: There are two scholarships, a \$2,000 award and \$1,000 award, sponsored by the Mounted Patrol Foundation, and Friends of Huddart and Wunderlich Parks.

Candidates can apply for the above scholarship awards by meeting ALL of the following requirements in the year in which the scholarship is awarded:

- 1. Be a high school junior or senior
- 2. Either A) be a rodeo contestant or B) be competing to be a Rodeo Queen/Princess at the 4th of July Woodside Junior Rodeo
- 3. Complete the Scholarship Application form, including the following:
 - Submit an essay describing your educational goals, and how these goals will help preserve both horsemanship and the western lifestyle that Bill Lane cultivated through his publishing business
 - Submit either a sealed academic transcript or an electronic transcript directly from your school
 - Submit two different clear photographs of yourself with your horse(s).
- 4. Completed and signed applications must be received by updated date of June 19th.

Candidates will be evaluated on several criteria, including, but not limited to:

- Rodeo involvement
- Financial need
- Academic record
- Extracurricular activities
- Work experiences
- Honors and awards
- Essay quality
